




**Chowan County and Town of Edenton

County Officials participated in a conference call with the State EOC this afternoon.




The image above is from the 6am update from the National Weather Service today, August 1, 2020.

If Hurricane Isaias continues on this track Chowan County and the Town of Edenton may experience the effects as early as late Monday evening into Tuesday morning. Generally, 2-5" of rain is expected area wide with locally higher amounts possible. There is a potential for elevated threats from tornadoes. Now is the time to check your hurricane plan and supplies.
