North Carolina Public Health has set up a call line where the public can direct any questions related to the Coronavirus, that number is 866-462-3821. County and Town employees will be operating with added safety precautions and we encourage all residents and businesses to follow public health officials' suggested safety measures:

- **Wash hands frequently with soap and hot water**
- **Avoid touching your face**
- **Avoid shaking people's hands (fist bump or elbow bump instead)**
- **Cover your mouth with you elbow when coughing or sneezing**
- **Maintain at least three feet between yourself and people who are coughing or sneezing**
