James Iredell

Born at Lewes Sussex County England October 5th 1750

Emigrated to North Carolina in 1768

Died at Edenton October 20th 1799

Having filled honorably to himself and usefully to his country various important civil offices, He was at the time of his death one of the associate Justices of the Supreme Court of the United States.

He was exemplary in the purity of his life and most affectionate kind and benevolent in all his domestic and social relations

Revolutionary Patriot James Iredell

Associate Justice US Supreme Court

1790-1799 and a leader in the cause for independence, Placed by Edenton Tea Party

He left this transitory world the 17th August 1816 in the 83rd year of his age

She the 23rd of January 1801 in the 50th year of her age

Loved honoured and lamented as the kindest and most affectionate of Parents

Their memories shall live in the heart of their children until they meet again in another and we trust far better world to part no more

Samuel Johnston was member of Congress in 1781

Governor of the State of North Carolina in 1788 and 1789

President of the Convention of the State that adopted the Federal Constitution in 1789

Senator to Congress in 1790 and Judge of the Supreme Court in 1800 after which period he refused all Public Employment

He never courted popular favour while few received more substantial evidence of Public Confidence

He was truly an honest man
